### SENIOR HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFITS ASSISTANCE

## Community & Economic Development

### YAQUINA BAY BROWNFIELDS INITIATIVE

The Siletz Tribe applied for a multi-purpose grant to help take the next step in the clean up of the Toledo Mill Site that was part of the Yaquina Bay Brownfields Initiative (YBBI). This grant allows for more planning and also clean-up if received. The YBBI only allowed for planning/environmental testing and not clean-up. OCWCOG helped the Tribe with the RFP for grant writing help.



### COLLABORATION OPPORTUNITIES

OCWCOG provides a variety of collaboration opportunities, including City Manager and Administrator meetings that are regularly attending by Tribe members, strengthening the relationship between OCWCOG and the Tribe.
