CASCADES WEST RIDE LINE

Provided 5,601 rides to residents

Cascades West Ride Line coordinates transportation services for eligible Oregon Health Plan (OHP) and Medicaid clients traveling to and from covered non-emergency medical services.



BROWNFIELD WORKPLAN Assistance

Staff assisted the city with an EPA Brownfield Workplan to help clean up land contaminated by hazardous substances or contaminants, making them usable for the community.

CASCADES WEST BUSINESS LENDING

Cascades West Business Lending supports small businesses in Lincoln City with **2** active loans totaling **\$221,908** and creating at least **6** jobs in the city. In 2023, **2** loans were paid off by Lincoln City businesses.
