#### HOUSING SERVICES SUCCESS

Housing Navigator Chiho was actively working with a Waldport resident who was struggling to maintain her living situation. At one of their scheduled home visits, Chiho found that the consumer was extremely disoriented and determined that she hadn't checked her blood sugar in a few days. Chiho assisted EMS and encouraged the consumer to go to the hospital by also ensuring her that her dogs would be cared for. Ultimately, the consumer landed in an Adult Foster Home, but remains stable with appropriate care, and is recovering.
