#### AGING & DISABILITY RESOURCE CONNECTION (ADRC)

The ADRC is a **free** service providing a single point of entry to resources, information, and assistance on issues affecting older adults and people with disabilities regardless of their income.

## CASCADES WEST RIDE LINE (CWRL)

CWRL is the region's Non-Emergent Medical Transportation (NEMT) providing rides to medical appointments for eligible Oregon Health Plan (OHP) and some Medicare clients.

## CASCADES WEST ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT

COG provides the administrative staffing for the federally-designated Cascades West Economic Development District (CWEDD), which encompasses the counties of Linn, Benton, Lincoln, and Lane. For the first time in 10 years, the CWEDD held a regional economic meeting, hosted and facilitated by our COG staff. This milestone meeting kicked-off the update to our regional 2025-2030 Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy plan.
