### Senior & Disability Services

#### ELIGIBILITY SERVICES & MEDICAL CASES

Medicaid-funded programs in partnership with the ODHS, providing essential support to eligible Oregonians. Including, medical, food, financial assistance, childcare, and more.

#### CASE MANAGEMENT & LONG TERM CARE

2,806 total cases supported across the region, including for those receiving in-home care, in a nursing facility, assisted living center, residential care facility, or Adult Foster Home.

#### ADULT PROTECTIVE SERVICES (APS)

Trained APS workers respond to reports of physical, financial, and other types of abuse, mistreatment, and neglect of older adults and people with disabilities.

OPI provides monthly support for daily activities, such as personal care, meal prep, housekeeping, and more. Helping seniors and people with disabilities maintain quality of life.


We partner with schools and more to provide the Foster Grandparent program, connecting volunteers aged 55+ with children 3 - 18 years old to gain personal and academic confidence.

## CASCADES WEST ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT

COG provides the administrative staffing for the federally-designated Cascades West Economic Development District (CWEDD), which encompasses the counties of Linn, Benton, Lincoln, and Lane. We partner with Lane Council of Governments (LCOG) to provide economic development planning and priority-setting for this region. **For the first time in 10 years, the CWEDD held a regional economic meeting, hosted and facilitated by our COG staff.** This milestone meeting brought together the two councils of governments and many regional stakeholders and partners in economic development. It also kicked-off the update to our regional 2025-2030 Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS) plan.
